# I. ESTABLISHMENT OF A QUORUM AND CALL TO ORDER

Chairman, Mark Hanson, established a quorum and called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

#### II. RECOGNITION OF VISITORS/PUBLIC COMMENT

Mark Allen, O & G Industries; Kenneth Biega, O & G Industries; W. Albert Jacunski, Jacunski & Humes Architects, LLC; Gus Kotait, O & G Industries; Bernard Pisacich, Town Treasurer; Tom Wagner, Town Planner

Residents of Spinnaker Road, Ms. Rachel Levine, Mr. James Cawley, and Dr. and Mrs. Robert Levin attended this meeting. Mr. James Cawley addressed the School Building Committee regarding the Great Neck School Construction Project and the impact it is having on his property. Noise was an issue during the drilling of the geothermal wells and the use of his back yard and pool during the summer months was impossible. Mr. Cawley stated that Dr. Collins stopped the construction for one day so that his granddaughter could have a party. Mr. Cawley also stated that some of the equipment was going onto his private property without permission. Mr. Cawley also had a problem with the number of trees that were shown in a drawing that he had been given as part of an agreement that he signed.

Dr. Collins will have someone go over the drawings with Mr. Cawley to explain the agreement regarding the trees. Dr. Collins will look into the noise problem to see what can be done to comply with the noise ordinance in the Town of Waterford.

Dr. Robert Levin also discussed the agreement regarding the trees, and showed drawing which showed no trees on it. Mrs. Levin thanked Dr. Collins for the meetings they had at various times regarding their property, and showed pictures of their fully wooded property before the construction started and showed pictures of their property now with the small replacement trees in place. Dr. and Mrs. Levin feel that their privacy is nonexistent at this time, and it will take another five to ten years or more for the trees to mature to where they will have their privacy back. They also stated that they have a problem with the noise from delivery trucks and other trucks beeping as those trucks back up when making deliveries very early in the morning.

In response to a question by Mr. Cannamela, all residents indicated that all the tree cutting has been confined to school property.

Dr. Collins, Mr. Wagner, Mr. Jacunski, Mr. Biega, and Mr. Allen, will look into all those matters to see if these matters can be resolved.

## VI. QUAKER HILL SCHOOL

Architect's Report Quaker Hill School: Jacunski Humes, LLC

Mr. Jacunski reported that they are waiting for the Punch List to be done. There is a meeting scheduled with the Mason on Tuesday to resolve some final issues. They are waiting for the final inspection to be done.

## Construction Manager's Report Quaker Hill School: O & G

Mr. Biega reported that they are waiting for the Punch List to be done. Some final site work needs to be done. There may be some issues with the Mason.

Mr. Wilensky asked about some questions that came up on the generator. He met unofficially with the Fire Marshall and the generator was running as it should be. Mr. Miner said that a recommendation was made to add an emergency light in Mr. Warner's room because it is an interior space. Dr. Collins suggested that a generator that can run the entire school, or an additional generator that can be added to run the entire school should be looked into. Dr. Collins would like to get prices on the generators.

# VII. OSWEGATCHIE SCHOOL Architect's Report Oswegatchie School: Jacunski Humes Architects

Mr. Jacunski reported that there are two punch lists, the roof and the sitework, which should be completed soon. They will wait for the final inspection.

Mr. Wilensky commented that when he last visited the Oswegatchie School, he noticed that some of the sidewalks just ended abruptly. He asked if the sidewalks were to be extended. Mr. Jacunski said that sidewalks were an issue with Planning and Zoning and some sidewalks had to be removed. Additional sidewalks may be a major issue.

#### Construction Manager's Report Oswegatchie School: O & G

Mr. Kotait showed slides of the Bus Loop on September 15<sup>th</sup> when the Bus Loop was not finished. The next slide showed the completed Bus Loop on September 29<sup>th</sup> with buses on the Bus Loop when it opened on that date.

Sitework-hydroseeding was done on October 2<sup>nd</sup>, the plantings are done, the site lights are done, and the swale rework was started today. Commissioning is ongoing, the Sitework Punch List will be started on October 26<sup>th</sup>, and the owner training is ongoing.

#### VII. GREAT NECK SCHOOL

Architect's Report Great Neck School: Jacunski Humes, LLC

Mr. Jacunski reported that they are working with O & G on the construction process. They are winding down on the shop drawings now.

# Construction Manager's Report Great Neck School: O & G

Mr. Allen showed slides of the progress at Great Neck School over the last two weeks. The first slide showed Building A and the west elevation that showed the scaffolding where the bricks are going up. The bricks may be up to the windows this coming week. The windows may be coming in this week also. The framing at the top of the stairs was also shown. The West Pod scaffolding is now down. The North East elevation and east pod showed the veneer. The administration area on Building B was shown. The block is on in that area. The Gym building B mechanical area was shown. The mason is coming up to about 5 feet now. The mechanical penthouse was shown on Building A where the flashing is going up. The geothermal well field has been graded and screened. The seeding will be taking place soon.
